General Note

Based on Article 13 of the Swiss Federal Constitution and the federal data protection provisions (Data Protection Act, DPA), every person has the right to protection of their privacy and protection against misuse of their personal data. We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the statutory data protection regulations and this privacy policy. In cooperation with our hosting providers, we endeavor to protect the databases as well as possible against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or falsification. We point out that data transmission over the Internet (e.g., when communicating by e-mail) may have security gaps. Complete protection of data against access by third parties is not possible. Edit Personal Data

We process personal data in accordance with Swiss data protection law. In addition, we process personal data – to the extent that the EU GDPR applies – on the following legal bases in connection with Art. 6 (1) GDPR:

- (c) Processing of personal data to fulfill a legal obligation to which we
subject to any applicable EU law or any applicable law of a country where the GDPR is
applicable in whole or in part
- lit. d) Processing of personal data to protect vital interests of the data subject
to protect a person or another natural person
- lit. f) Processing of personal data for the legitimate interests of us or of
to safeguard the legitimate interests of third parties, unless the fundamental freedoms
and fundamental rights and interests of the data subject prevail. Legitimate interests
include, in particular, our business interest in being able to provide our website,
information security, the enforcement of our own legal claims, and compliance with Swiss
law.

We process personal data for as long as is necessary for the relevant purpose or purposes. Where we are subject to longer retention obligations under statutory or other requirements, we restrict processing accordingly.

Cookie Policy

This website uses cookies. These are small text files that make it possible to store

specific, user-related information on the user's device while they are using the website. Cookies allow, in particular, to determine the frequency of use and the number of users of the pages, to analyze patterns of website use, but also to make our offer more customer-friendly. Cookies remain stored beyond the end of a browser session and can be retrieved upon a subsequent visit to the site. Own reach measurement

This website uses exclusively a self-operated, proprietary reach measurement on our own infrastructure. No third-party services are used, and no data is transmitted to third parties or to third countries.

With each page view, we capture and store the page accessed, the referral source (referrer), the browser type, the language setting, the timestamp, and the IP address of the accessing device. No cookies are set for this measurement and no cross-device user profiles are created.

The purpose of the processing is the statistical evaluation of the use of our website in order to provide our offering in a technically secure and needs-based manner and to continuously improve it. The legal basis is our legitimate interest (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR) and the corresponding provisions of the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP).

The collected data remains exclusively with us and will not be passed on to third parties. We only store it for as long as is necessary for the stated purpose and then delete it.

Privacy Policy for SSL/TLS Encryption

For security reasons and to protect the transmission of confidential content, such as the requests you send to us as the site operator, this website uses SSL/TLS encryption. You can recognize an encrypted connection by the fact that the browser's address bar changes from "http://" to "https://" and by the lock icon in your browser bar. Privacy Policy for Contact Form

Contractual Services

We process the data of our contractual partners and prospects as well as other principals,

customers, mandators, clients or contractual partners (uniformly referred to as "contractual partners") in accordance with the data protection provisions of the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP) and the EU GDPR pursuant to Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR in order to provide them with our contractual or pre-contractual services. The data processed in this context, the type, scope, and purpose, and the necessity of their processing are determined by the underlying contractual relationship. The processed data includes the master data of our contractual partners (e.g., names and addresses), contact data (e.g., email addresses and telephone numbers), as well as contract data (e.g., services utilized, contract contents, contractual communication, names of contact persons) and payment data (e.g., bank account details, payment history). As a rule, we do not process special categories of personal data unless they are part of a commissioned or contractual processing. We process data required for the establishment and fulfillment of contractual services and point out the necessity of providing such data if this is not evident to the contractual partners. Disclosure to external persons or companies only takes place if it is necessary within the framework of a contract. When processing data provided to us as part of an assignment, we act in accordance with the instructions of the principals and the statutory requirements. In the context of using our online services, we may store the IP address and the time of the respective user action. This storage is based on our legitimate interests as well as the interests of the users in protection against misuse and other unauthorized use. As a rule, this data is not passed on to third parties unless it is necessary for the enforcement of our claims pursuant to Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR or there is a legal obligation to do so pursuant to Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR. The data is deleted when it is no longer required for the fulfillment of contractual or statutory duties of care or for dealing with any warranty and comparable obligations, whereby the necessity of retaining the data is reviewed at irregular intervals. In all other respects, the statutory retention obligations apply.
